Agent الفاعل الفعلي = the one/thing that really performing the action or making a change (e.g. Ahmed and Ali sent a long letter. A long letter was sent by Ahmed and Ali.)

Patient المفعول به الفعلي = the one/thing that undergoes the action or change (e.g. Ahmed sent a long letter. A long letter was sent by Ahmed.)

V1 = verb in its base form without any changes or additions (e.g. go, buy, live, send, write, help, check,)

V2= verb in the past simple tense. Most only take –ed (lived, helped, checked,) Plus there are irregular verbs (e.g. went, bought, sent, wrote,)

V3= Past participle. Most only take –ed (lived, helped, checked,) Plus there are irregular verbs (e.g. gone, bought, sent, written,)
