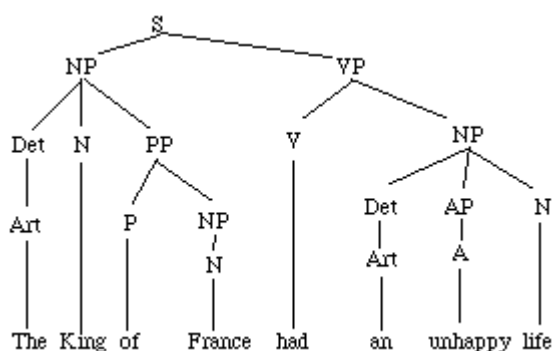
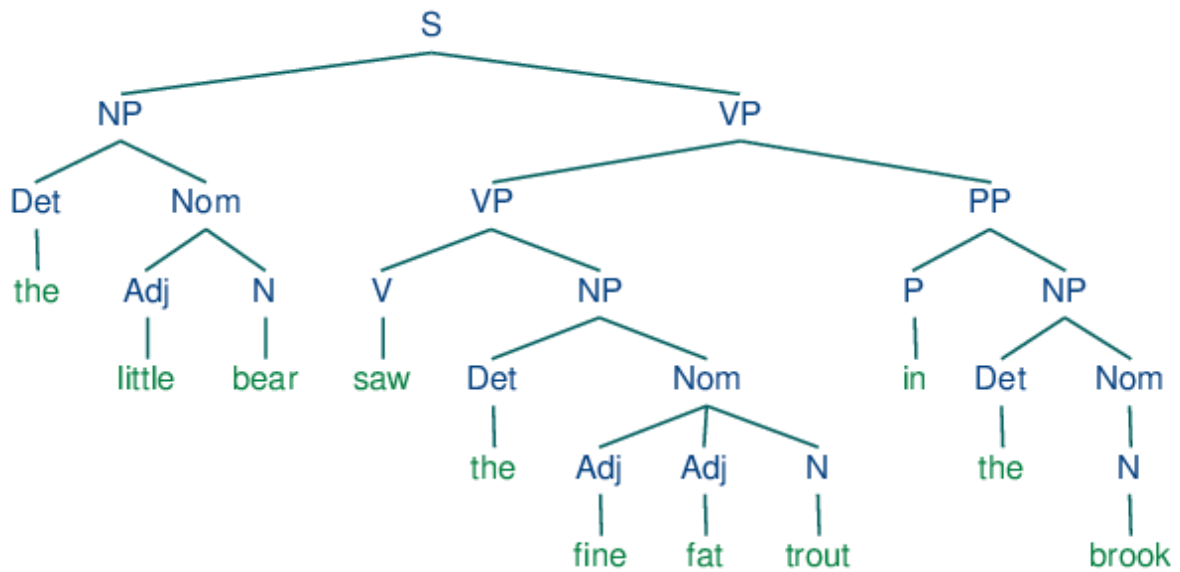


Tree Diagrams

8. I can have some apple juice or a coke.

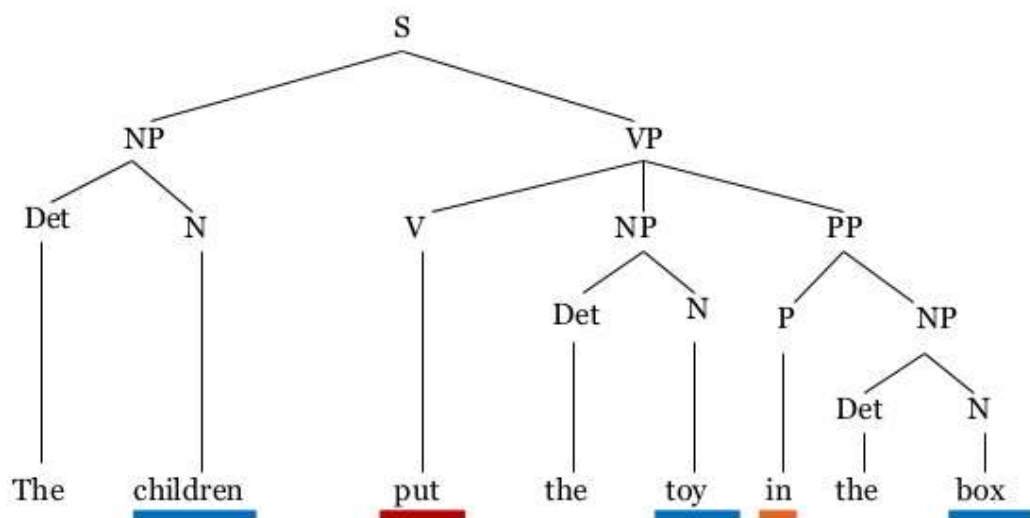




How to Build a Tree (O'Grady, p. 181)

The children / like the toy.



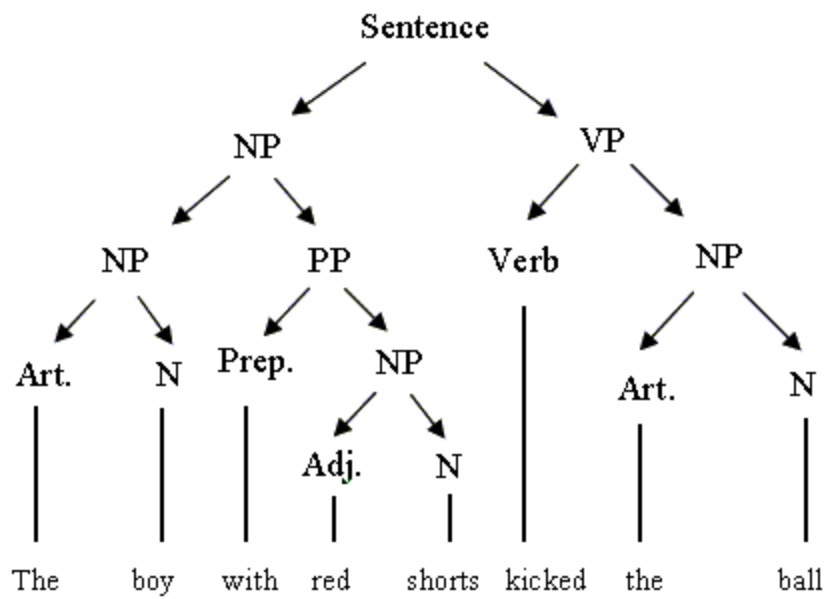


Figure 1.1.2.
