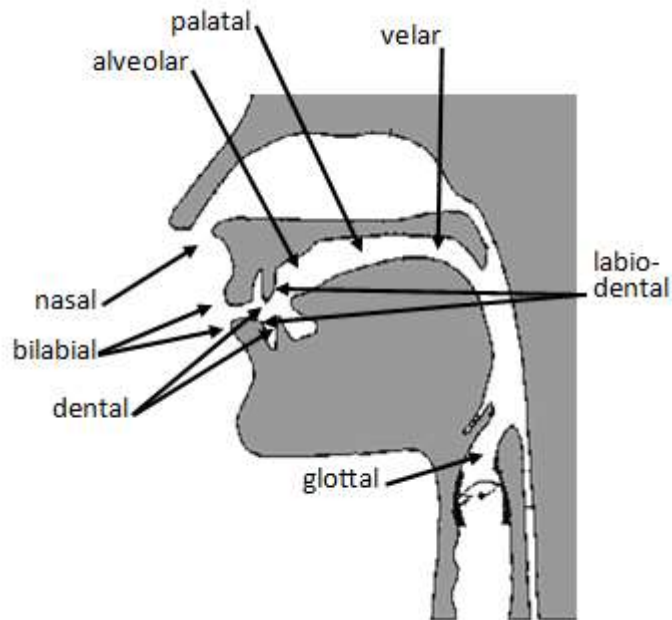


1. Memorise the places of articulation in the figure (the cross-section of the head) in Chapter 3.

3. Now describe each consonant as in the example:

/p/ voiceless, bilabial

/b/ voiced bilabial

/m/ voiced bilabial
